Poppies and Poppy merchandise such as keyrings, wristbands and badges are available to buy from both the Upper School and Lower School Reception.



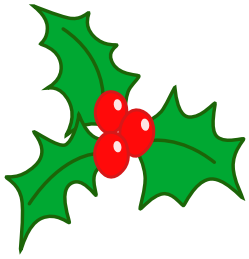
REMINDER...!
