It is so nice to have the children back - so good that they can mix with their friends in their bubble at school.

However the lockdown is still in force and Covid rules are still important.

### Remember

**HANDS** - Wash your hands regularly and for 20 seconds.

**FACE** - Wear a face covering in indoor settings where social distancing may be difficult, and where you will come into contact with people you do not normally meet.

**SPACE** - Stay 2 metres apart from people you do not live with. Where you cannot stay 2 metres apart you should stay more than 1 metre apart, and take additional steps to stay safe - such as wearing face coverings or increasing ventilation indoors.

For example:

You must wear a face covering on the playground when you drop off or pick up your child.

Do not stop or wait around on the playground to chat to other parents.

Bring only your own child to and from school unless you are in a support bubble.

You must not allow your child to meet socially with others - even if they meet together at school.

You should still limit close contact as much as possible - no sleep overs for another few months!
